## 1. Rules

- At the end of the individual qualification ranking round, the first 16 teams (men and women) are entered into 4 groups of 4 teams, according to the following scheme:

<b>Group 1</b>	<b>Group 2</b>	<b>Group 3</b>	<b>Group 4</b>
1 <sup>st</sup>	2 <sup>nd</sup>	3 <sup>rd</sup>	4 <sup>th</sup>
8 <sup>th</sup>	7 <sup>th</sup>	6 <sup>th</sup>	5 <sup>th</sup>
9 <sup>th</sup>	10 <sup>th</sup>	11 <sup>th</sup>	12 <sup>th</sup>
16 <sup>th</sup>	15 <sup>th</sup>	14 <sup>th</sup>	13 <sup>th</sup>

- In each group each team competes against the three others in the group. At the end of these 3 matches, a ranking in each group is established by the allocation of following points :

won match	2 points
lost match	1 point
w.o. (withdraw)	0 point

At this stage of the competition, all the teams have shot three matches.

- \* After the group-matches rounds, the first 8 teams (when there are 16 teams participating) or the first 4 teams (participation of 8 teams) will be allocated 2 extra point.

### Handling of ties:

- Tie at the end of a match:  
shoot-off according to the FITA rules
- After the 3 group matches:  
the total score of the 3 team-matches decides the tie
  - when there is still a tie:  
shoot-off according to the FITA rules

After the groups' matches, the following situation exists:

### Ranking matches: 2 matches for all teams.

- **Match 1:** the teams at the same rank in the 4 groups meet to establish their final ranking:  
teams of group nr. 1 meet the teams of the group 4  
teams of group nr. 2 meet the teams of the group 3
- **Match 2:** the winners and the losers of the first match shoot against each other. If the timing allows it, the two winners amongst the 1<sup>st</sup> of match nr. 1, can shoot their (final) match separately, otherwise all teams shoot together.

At the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> match:

the 1<sup>st</sup> of each "group" are ranked from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 4<sup>th</sup> position  
the 2<sup>nd</sup> of each "group" are ranked from the 5<sup>th</sup> to the 8<sup>th</sup> position  
the 3<sup>rd</sup> of each "group" are ranked from the 9<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup> position  
the 4<sup>th</sup> of each "group" are ranked from the 13<sup>th</sup> to the 16<sup>th</sup> position.

In case of a tie at the end of match nr 1 or 2:

shoot-off according to the FITA rules.

The winner of the final round of the European Clubteams Cup (men and women) wins the
